Guard nabs boy in school classroom

A MALE juvenile was caught red-handed while breaking into a classroom at Harristown State High School.

A security guard from CK9-SAS Toowoomba located the boy in a classroom when responding to an alarm about 11.30pm on Thursday.

Toowoomba Criminal Investigation Branch acting officer-in-charge Tony Morris said the boy had smashed a glass door panel to get into the room.

Detective Acting Senior Sergeant Morris said the boy

was helping police with their inquiries, but no charges had been laid yesterday.

Meanwhile, Oakey State High School and Oakey Sand and Gravel were broken into on Thursday night in similar style raids.

Oakey police acting officer-in-charge Chris Brameld said someone cut a padlock to gain entry to a sports shed at the high school but nothing was taken.

Acting Sergeant Brameld said a padlock was also cut at Oakey Sand and Gravel in Hamlyn Rd before entry was gained to a building.

Again, nothing was reported stolen.

Investigations are continuing.
